Akinkugbe, UNIMED celebrate Mimiko

The Chairman, Governing Council of University of Medical Sciences, Emeritus Professor Oladipupo Akinkugbe, on Thursday February 9, 2017 hosted the outgoing Governor of Ondo State, Olusegun Mimiko, to a luncheon in celebration of the governor's successful tenure.

The special luncheon, which held at Akinkugbe's residence in Ondo City, was supervised by officials of UNIMED.

It was a gathering of eminent personalities, including the Osemawe of Ondo Kingdom, Oba Dr. Adesimbo Kiladejo and prominent Ondo chiefs as well as top government officials.

Also in attendance were members of UNIMED governing council, staff and students of the university. In his opening remarks, the host, Akinkugbe, said Mimiko was the only Ondo State Governor that had spent two terms of eight years in office.

"Universities come and go, but it is posterity that

will determine where the currency of their contribution will be in gold or in gabage. I am sure posterity will rank Governor Mimiko as one of the best governors that has served Ondo State." Akinkugbe said. The Vice Chancellor of UNIMED, Prof. Friday Okonofua while reading the citation of the Governor noted that before his assumption of office, 'Ondo state was the only state in southern Nigeria, if not the entire country, that did not have a standard institution for the training of health professionals.'

He praised Mimiko for being the first governor of the state to address the need by establishing the first University of Medical Sciences in Nigeria. Mimiko expressed his appreciation to the University's Governing Council and members of staff and students for the reception.

"Suddenly, it is eight years already but looking back, i just thank God almighty. And it is not a coincidence that this is the first formal reception for me on my way to becoming an ex-governor very soon. I thank you sir. This is very thoughtful of you and the entire council", Mimiko said.

A member of the Governing Council, Mrs Olufunmilayo Amodu presented gifts to the Governor on behalf of the Council, Staff and Students of the university.

Okonofua kick-starts 2017 donations to FUF

Two members of staff of the University of Medical Sciences, Ondo City, have been elected to the Governing Council of UNIMED by the university's congregation. In the election held at the Faculty of Basic Medical Sciences lecture theater, the Director of Physical Planning, Architect Adesanya Taiwo, and the **Director of Advancement** and Documentation, Prof. Abimbola Akintade, got elected with 21 and 16 votes respectively. The three losers in the election- the Deputy

Registrar (Academics), Mr Adeyinka Adekalu; the Director of Guidance and Counseling Unit, Dr (Mrs) Benny Okei; and the Legal Officer, Mrs Damilola Adejumopolled 10, 9 and 4 votes respectively. The Vice Chancellor, **UNIMED** and Chairman of the Congregation, Prof. Friday Okonofua congratulated Taiwo and Akintade on their
